ACSA's New Superintendents Seminar Series (formerly known as Leading the Leaders), is a professional learning program that has successfully assisted first and second year superintendents for over sixteen years. The program places participants into a yearlong cohort and tackles the current issues faced by superintendents in five workshop settings.
